FAMOUS FACE

For the record, he played against Power House in C Grade on both occasions (at Fawkner Park 5) and in one of the matches was dismissed for a duck (LBW) by MCA Fawkner Park match secretary Gurav Gupta!



EAR TO THE GROUND

Como Park is a beautiful ground to umpire at, with the massive over hanging pavilion and large scoreboard. However, for players, Como Park presents an inherent risk, with 2 cricket matches often being played simultaneously on slightly overlapping ovals. This issue came to fruition in 2019 when Stonnington Council banned this practice of 2 grounds sharing space, for safety reasons, much to South Yarra Cricket Club's dismay.

The Club protested arguing that there had been 50 years of incident free play, despite outfielders sometimes being in another game's playing area. The ban had the potential to split the club and eventually a compromise was reached. Como Park was redeveloped and the cricket ovals resized to meet safety standards.

Today, umpires will have noticed that the 2 grounds still slightly overlap, and a risk still exists, but the Council have accepted this as an acceptable risk, so play on!



RULES RECAP

Can play be from one end only, if ground/pitch is unreasonable from one end? Yes.

Umpires can rule that play can occur with bowling from one end only. Umpires and batsmen shall change ends after each over. Important: Bowling shall continue from the one end for the rest of the day. **Rule 8.5**

What is the latest time, by agreement between the captains, can a match be delayed to as a T20? 3.30pm **Rule 14.7 (b)**

T20: How long is the first power play – 2 fielders allowed outside circle. 6 overs. **Rule 16.6 b (i)**

Can the tea break be reduced from the standard 30 minutes? Yes. Umpires may reduce to 25 minutes at their discretion. If both captains agree, the time for the tea interval can also be reduced by up to 15 minutes. **Rule 14.3 (a) and (b)**

Which type of balls can be used in MCA matches? 4-piece balls only **Rule 6.1**
